- School Colors: Blue and Gold
- School Nickname: “Mount”
- On August 15, 1907, the school was opened to six boarders with a staff of five Sisters. Sister Philomena Madden was placed in charge of the enterprise.
- Originally started as a boys and girls school, but in 1933 the Dominican sisters decided to concentrate on an all girls high school
- Classes varied from foreign language, mathematics, science, physical ed., home economics
- Due to financial difficulties, the school closed in 1972 with 110 graduates that spring.
